Please tick the trace elements required. Due to the variability of liver copper, the recommended minimum sample size is now 10 which will provide a more accurate indicator of herd copper status. For other trace elements, a minimum of 5 samples is recommended. If you require more or less to be sampled please write the new number in the box. It is advisable to discuss this with your veterinarian first.

Cattle (beef or dairy) ≥10 x Copper 5 x Selenium 5 x Cobalt 5 x Zinc

Sheep or lambs (age required) ≥10 x Copper 5 x Selenium 5 x Cobalt 5 x Zinc

Deer ≥10 x Copper 5 x Selenium

The results of these tests will be sent to your veterinarian. Your vet will be able to provide an interpretation and recommendations from your mineral check results and will invoice you for the complete service.

MineralCheck trace element monitoring is a strategic management tool that can help you maximise production and minimise expenditure by identifying the trace element status of your animals. While information can be obtained by blood sampling and liver biopsies taken from live animals, liver sampling is an effective and convenient method when animals go to the meat works. The liver sampling is available through all the meat works and the service also includes a visual assessment of the livers for liver fluke, liver eczema and abscesses

Procedure:

- A copy of this form **must** be completed and given to the stock truck driver to deliver to the meat works with your declaration card/trucking documents.
- Please ensure a copy is faxed to AsureQuality at the meat work premises well before you send the stock.
